When searching for eklund the details page is displayed immediately and it contains the picture of the person.


When searching for "APP MG1VAPPP01 - RAD SysTest Office Fund_Turnover (RX)" the details page of the AD group is displayed immediately.



- COBs work doesn't appear to have an end state











Application	Curimary
Business Overview	CORONA is a collateral reporting tool for OTC (Over The Counter) trades used by the Risk team to generate extracts used to send to collateral managers to indicate which trades to collateralise as well as for internal reports. It is the replacement application for the Risk OTC Valuation (Access) system.
Technical Overview	The application sources trade information from FODB via Frontier for FFX trades (Forward FX) and directly from ARA files produced from ALGO for other OTC trades (e.g. CDS, CDX, IRS, Inflation Swaps). The various processes of the application are as follows:
	Stage - Extracts data from Frontier/ARA files in their raw format into staging tables
	Import - Filters out irrelevant trade types, maps codes (e.g. counterparty, fund) using Bacardi mappings
	Match - Joins the legs of trades together and calculates MTM (Mark- to-Market)
	Analytics - Shows MTM movements above a particular tolerance
	Report - Generate extracts for internal/external distribution

TL;DR The software craftsmanship community are welcoming, supportive and a fabulous bunch of diverse people. The SoCraTes UK 2016 event was excellent and I would definitely go again!

As Jonathan has already mentioned, I had the genuine pleasure of participating from Thursday to Sunday last week in the annual SoCraTes UK 2016 "unconference" in the scenic Wotton House hotel in Surrey. The event was organized by Codurance and the London Software Craftsmanship Community (this link won't work at work!) as a means of bringing together people interested in sharing and learning about software craftsmanship and improving our profession.

This was the first unconference and open space event I'd been to, which basically means that there is no preset agenda and list of speakers as per a regular conference. Instead, each participant is invited to propose sessions for anyone in the group to attend which included coding sessions (e.g. katas and technology hands on), group discussions and presentations. The unconference style meant that delegates were free to carry on with sessions as long as they like (i.e. into the night!) beyond the core hours of 9am to 6pm. Sandro Mancuso, who is facilitating the Code Dojos for the CAD Team, was certainly taking advantage of this and was mostly nocturnal!





Each day started with an "open circle" where delegates queued to pitch their session ideas to everyone and then place their sessions on a "marketplace" wall which essentially mapped timeslots to available meeting places, as seen in the marketplace pictures below for Saturday and Sunday:
